

LOCAL LAW NO. 1  
OF 1982 OF THE TOWN OF LEE  
ENTITLED "RESTRICTION OF  
LIABILITY OF THE TOWN OF  
LEE, COUNTY OF ONEIDA AND STATE  
OF NEW YORK UNDER CERTAIN  
CONDITIONS".

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Lee, County of Oneida and State of New York as follows:

Section One: No civil action shall be maintained against the Town of Lee, County of Oneida and State of New York or the Highway Superintendent of the Town of Lee, County of Oneida and State of New York for damages or injuries to person or persons or property sustained in consequence of any street, highway, right of way, bridge, culvert, sewer line, water line, storm sewer drain, storm water drain, sidewalks, cross walks or curbs or curbs being defective, out of repairs, improperly maintained, unsafe, dangerous or obstructed, or for damages or injuries to person or property sustained solely in consequence of the existence of snow, ice or other debris upon any street, highway, right of way, bridge, culvert, sewer line, water line and storm sewer drain, water drain, sidewalk, cross walk or curb unless written notice of the defective, improperly maintained, unsafe, dangerous or obstructed condition, or of the existence of the snow, ice, or other debris relating to the particular place in the Town of Lee, County of Oneida and State of New York, is actually given to the Town Clerk of the Town of Lee, County of Oneida and State of New York, and there was a failure or neglect within a reasonable time after the receipt of such notice, to repair, correct or remove the defect, danger or obstruction complained of, or to cause the snow, ice or other debris to be removed or the place otherwise made reasonably safe.

Section Two: This local law shall take effect upon the filing of all proper papers, the publication of all proper notices and after the forwarding of same to the Department of State for their records.
