

LEE TOWN PARK ORDINANCE, TOWN OF LEE, ONEIDA  
COUNTY, NEW YORK, ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 13, 1971  
TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1, 1971

*No. 1971-2*

Section 1 - Site

The regulations hereinafter mentioned shall apply to those premises owned by the Town of Lee located on the west side of Turin Road and hereinafter designated as Lee Town Park.

Section 2 - Regulations

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to use the Lee Town Park between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., unless otherwise authorized. Use for snowmobiling is authorized between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. on designated trails only.

2. Except for snowmobiles, it shall be unlawful for any person to park or to operate a motor vehicle on the Lee Town Park except in designated parking areas or on the roadways.

3. It shall be unlawful for any person to damage or destroy any buildings, fences or other property located upon the Lee Town Park.

4. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm into or upon the Lee Town Park.

5. It shall be unlawful for any person to place, deposit or dump anything of any nature on the Lee Town Park except within a designated disposal or otherwise permitted by sign or other directive.

6. It shall be unlawful for any person to use alcoholic beverages with the Lee Town Park except for family groups in the picnic area or by special permit authorized by the Town Board.

7. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn fires within the Lee Town Park except in picnic area fire places or other specifically authorized locations.

#### Section 3 - Violation

Any violation of any provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed an offense, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$25.00 for each offense.

#### Section 4 - Saving Clause

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be contained in operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall be deemed surrendered.
