

ORDINANCE NO. TWO OF THE TOWN
BOARD OF THE TOWN OF LEE, COUNTY
OF ONEIDA AND STATE OF NEW YORK
FOR FRESHWATER WETLANDS PROTECTION
AUGUST 24, 1976.

BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to Section 24-0501 of Article 24 of the Environmental Conservation Law, in relation to the regulation, management, protection and conservation of the freshwater wetlands within the Town of Lee, the Town of Lee hereby adopts and sets forth as its ordinance for freshwater wetlands protection, the provisions of such Article 24 including the procedures and concepts contained therein, except that the provisions of such Article 24 to the extent authorized shall be administered by the Town of Lee as provided herein.

Furthermore, after issuance of the official Freshwater Wetlands Map for the Town of Lee or any portion thereof, pursuant to Section 24-0301 of said article, any person desiring to conduct on freshwater wetlands as so designated in such map of the regulated activities set forth in Section 24-0701(2) of said Article, must obtain a permit from the Town Clerk of the Town of Lee.

In granting or denying the permit the Town Clerk shall be guided by the provisions of Section 24-0705. Any appeals from the decision of the Town Clerk shall be taken in accordance with the provisions of Section 24-1103 of said Article.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that there shall be no fee for the applying for or granting of a permit, but that the penalties set forth in said Article for a violation thereof constitute a civil penalty as provided in Section 71-2303

of the said Article.
