

NOTICE OF PASSAGE OF ORDINANCE
NO. TWO OF 1980 FOR THE TOWN OF
LEE, ONEIDA COUNTY, NEW YORK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance was duly passed and adopted at a Public Hearing held on the 10th day of November, 1980 and shall become effective ten (10) days after the posting and publication of this Notice. Said ordinance passed on the 10th day of November, 1980 is known as Ordinance No. Two of 1980 of the Town of Lee, and is as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town of Lee together with other municipalities, is a member of the Northern Oneida County Landfill which operates a landfill in the Town of Lee; and

WHEREAS, in order to promote the health and safety of those residents located in said township, it is deemed necessary to regulate the pick-up of certain garbage and trash by commercial haulers picking up garbage, trash and other waste products within said township; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set forth certain rules and regulations in connection therewith,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the Town of Lee does hereby ordain as follows:

(A) Definitions - haulers of commercial garbage and trash shall be an individual or group of individuals, association or corporation which pick-up garbage and trash and other waste products for a fee, monetary or otherwise, from residents and property owners within the confines of the Town of Lee.

(B) This ordinance shall apply only within the boundaries of the Town of Lee.

(C) No commercial haulers of garbage, trash and/or other waste products shall be allowed to contract for, or pick-up, or haul away any garbage, trash, refuse or any other waste products within the confines of

the Town of Lee, or use the highways for the same without first securing a license to operate within the confines of the Town of Lee and paying a fee for the same. Applications shall be available and licenses shall be issued from the Town Clerk's Office during normal business hours. The yearly fee for said license shall be \$100.00. The license shall be for a calendar year or a portion thereof and shall be non-transferable. No rebates shall be allowed for any portion of a calendar year for which a licenser has not picked up garbage, trash or other waste products.

(D) In making the application, the applicant hereby agrees to be bound by all rules and regulations as set forth by the Town Board of the Town of Lee in this ordinance and the application.

(E) If any of said rules or regulations are violated, the Town Board of the Town of Lee shall have the right, after a hearing, to revoke or suspend said license for the balance of the calendar year. Licensors shall be notified of any violation by written notification at least ten (10) days before the hearing date and shall have an opportunity to be heard. The decision of the majority of the total membership of the Town Board of the Town of Lee shall be final and binding. As part of said decision, the Town Board shall have the power to suspend or revoke said license.

(F) No commercial hauler shall pick up garbage, or other waste products within the confines of the Town of Lee without first securing a valid license for the same.

(G) Failure to procure said license or to operate a motor vehicle without a license shall be deemed a violation and punishable by a fine of not more than \$150.00 or imprisonment for a period of not more than 15 days, or both.

(H) Each day shall be deemed a separate violation and shall be punishable accordingly.


(I) Licenses shall be carried at all times in the vehicles used to pick-up garbage, trash, and other waste products. In the event commercial haulers have more than one vehicle, for this purpose, duplicate

licenses shall be issued for each vehicle. Fees for duplicate licenses shall be \$2.00 per year.

(J) Licenses for each calendar year may be procured during the last month of the previous calendar year or during the calendar year.
