

**NOTICE OF PASSAGE**  
OF ORDINANCE NO. ONE FOR 1984  
TOWN OF LEE, ONEIDA COUNTY, NEW YORK


**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE**, that the annexed document, called Ordinance No. One for 1984 of the Town of Lee, Oneida County, New York, was duly enacted and passed at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Lee, Oneida County, New York, held on the 12th day of March, 1984, and was moved and seconded by those persons so noted thereon. That the text of the ordinance is as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Lee, New York as follows:

1. No vehicle will be parked or left standing unattended on any public street or roadway or highway or any portion thereof of the Town of Lee between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M. on each day during the period from November 1 to April 1 of the following year. Any motor vehicle found parked or left standing unattended in violation of the above shall be towed away at the owner's expense. In addition, the owner thereof, irrespective of whether or not he is the operator of said motor vehicle who is subsequently convicted of a violation of this ordinance may be subject to a fine of not more than \$50.00, or imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or both. This ordinance shall not apply to any disabled motor vehicle left unattended, providing however said owner or operator thereof gives immediate notice to the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Lee that in fact said motor vehicle is disabled, the location of same and when said motor vehicle will be removed from said roadway. For the purpose of this ordinance, roadways shall include shoulders of the same and any other untraveled portion of said roadway.

This ordinance shall take effect as soon as the proper signs are in place.
